MI5 SMEAR CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE IBMT'S JACK JAMES LARKIN JONES

MI5's authorised historian, Christopher Andrew, who had been formally required to join and swear a loyalty oath to MI5 itself in order to obtain that particular "Queen's shilling" commission, provides the professorial front for the professional liar and double agent Oleg Gordievsky.

MI5's smearing and slandering of the late President of the International Brigade Memorial Trust, Jack Jones, continues unabated. On February 10, 2010 Ulster TV screened the ITN-commissioned programme *INSIDE MI5* – with its closing words that "MI5 is proud of its history" – and which, in turn, is based on the MI5 Professor Christopher Andrew's book *The Defence of the Realm*. Jack Jones died on April 21, 2009. What Oleg Gordievsky immediately went on to allege did not, of course, constitute a libel on Jack, since - according to law one cannot libel a dead person. But his unashamedly malicious lie most certainly did <u>slander</u> Jack Jones. That *Telegraph* report was a lie in more ways than one, by also stating that such an allegation had first surfaced in 1995. <u>It most certainly had not</u>. In 1995 Gordievsky maintained that some KGB files held "information obtained" in conversations Jack Jones might have held with Soviet Government or Embassy officials. Jack chose to answer that charge politically. He did not need to take it further, for it was only when he was safely dead that the cowardly Gordievsky dared to proceed with his lying charge that Jack was a "paid KGB agent".

Gordievsky's moral cowardice, of course, undoubtedly made sound financial sense. He could not risk yet another libel action. Back in 1995 the *Sunday Times* had been required to pay substantial damages to Michael Foot, after publishing Gordievsky's earlier libel that this former leader of the British Labour Party was such a "paid KGB agent". "Once bitten, twice shy" accordingly became a new maxim for Goordievsky, a professional liar, as he was to be so accurately described in that same ITN programme by Jack's son, Mick Jones.

The very same day saw publication of the MI5 Andrew book, giving rise to a crescendo of black propaganda against the good name of our recently deceased founding President of the International Brigade Memorial Trust, who was also former General Secretary [1969-1978] of the Transport & General Workers' Union.
